SUBJECT - ENGLISH (Do any 2 Activities)

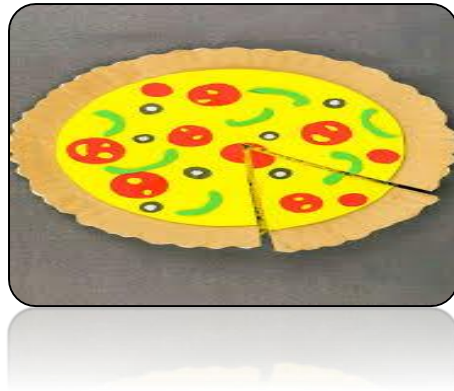

SUBJECT - MATHEMATICS (Do any 2 Activities)



Look for different patterns at home or in your surroundings. Find at least 10 examples of patterns such as tiles, rangoli, clothes, leaves, windows, grills, staircases, etc. Draw or paste pictures of the patterns in your notebook.



Draw or create paper pizzas divided into fractions. Show fractions such as $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{8}$. Create different “pizza orders” for family members. Write short word problems in your notebook like: “If 2 out of 8 slices are eaten, what fraction is left?”



Collect 5 interesting number facts or tricks. Example: Multiples of 9 pattern, Magic squares, Palindrome numbers. Explain each trick with examples in your notebook.



To connect fractions with money management and daily life. Ask parents about weekly household spending categories. Represent spending as fractions:

- Food
- Transport
- Electricity
- Savings
- Create a colourful pie chart or fraction chart.

Do this activity in your notebook.

SUBJECT – SOCIAL SCIENCE (Do any 1 Activity)



Make a research project on any two Indian states in your Social Science notebook:
Prepare a project file including the following information:
Name of the State

- Capital City
- Major Cities
- Geographical Features (Rivers, Mountains, Climate)
- Cultural Aspects (Language, Festivals, Traditional attire)
- Economy (Major industries, Agricultural products)
- Tourist Attractions (Famous places to visit)
- Include pictures, maps, and drawings.



Paste or draw pictures of any 5 community helpers (Doctor, Teacher, Police officer, farmer, etc.) and write 2 lines about each in your Social Science notebook.

SUBJECT - SCIENCE (Do any 1 Activity)



Make a colorful cover page of Project file with the title.
Draw pictures related to science such as:

- Bulb or inventions
- Etc
